

NEA REPRESENTATIVE ASSEMBLY DELEGATE DUTIES

NEA RA Delegates shall be and remain members of the Associated Chaffey Teachers (ACT), California Teachers Association (CTA), and the National Teachers Association (NEA).

Duties

- 1. Arrive at the Convention Center no later than the day prior to the start of the Representative Assembly in time to register as an official delegate to the Representative Assembly (RA) with both the California delegation and NEA and attend the morning California caucus. Delegates must remain throughout the convention.
- 2. Attend all caucuses of the California delegation, normally early in the morning.
- 3. Attend all business meetings of the RA.
- 4. Represent the Association to the best of his or her ability.
- 5. Represent the Association as directed by the Executive Board of Directors and/or the Representative Council.
- 6. Take into consideration CTA State Council and caucus policy when voting.
- 7. Participate fully in all activities of the California delegation.
- 8. Sit with our Service Center delegation on the RA floor.
- 9. Report on National Education Association actions and decisions to the Executive Board of Directors, the Representative Council, and/or the membership.
- 10. The term of office shall be three (3) years.
- 11. The number of local delegates to the NEA Representative Assembly shall be determined by CTA/NEA.
