

ACT CAMPUS DIRECTOR DUTIES

Campus Directors shall be and remain members of the Associated Chaffey Teachers (ACT), California Teachers Association (CTA), and the National Teachers Association (NEA).

- 1. Exercise all the business and organizational powers and duties for the Association as prescribed by law and these bylaws.
- 2. Act for the Representative Council when school is not in session.
- 3. Coordinate the activities of the Association; Adopt, amend, and publicize the local Standing Rules for the Association.
- 4. Recommend a budget for the Association to the Representative Council.
- 5. Approve by majority vote the President's appointments and removal of committee members, including chairpersons,
- 6. Approve by majority vote the President's appointments and by two-thirds (2/3) vote removal of bargaining team members.
- 7. Direct the bargaining activities of the Association, subject to the policies established by the Representative Council.
- 8. Adopt grievance procedure and direct the grievance activities of the Association.
